

# Horkans Lawn Moss Info leaflet.

## **Control Lawn moss in your Garden - NOW.**

Lawn moss continues to be a major problem in most lawns after the wet and very mild winter. Lawn moss continues to grow right through the autumn, winter and spring and competes directly with your lawn grass causing damage over the winter & Spring season. TAKE ACTION NOW TO KILL LAWN MOSS IN YOUR GARDEN

### **Three simple steps to a moss free lawn.**

1. Apply Lawn Mosskiller ( Sulphate of Iron ) Lightly now over the entire lawn area; YOU CAN APPLY through a watering can or scotts spreader – When using a watering can ( 2 gallon) put three heaped tablespoons of Sulphate of Iron into your can – fill the can with cold water and thoroughly mix – Apply the mixture to the lawn area effected with moss wetting the moss fully – AVOID SPREADING THE TREATMENT ON TARMAC OR PAVED AREAS.
2. Apply the Lawn Mosskiller by spreader over the entire area evenly, please follow the instructions on the bag or container.  
Alternatively apply the Lawn Mosskiller through a Scott lawn spreader, which has been adjusted to mark 10 and apply evenly over the entire area.



Horky's tip: apply Lawn mosskiller before rain is promised. Make sure none of the Lawn Mosskiller mixture splashes or lands on concrete or tarmac areas, as a stain will be left. Only apply Lawn mosskiller onto lawn areas.

3. Rake the heavy clumps of dead moss after a couple of days with a lawn rake to remove dead and unwanted moss.
4. Apply a dressing of RENOVATOR 3 in 1 lawn treatment to the entire lawn area this will green up the grass without forcing growth due to its unique slow released lawn fertiliser. RENOVATOR will also eliminate broadleaved weeds and feed your lawn for a long period.



Horky's tip: apply a second dressing of RENOVATOR in mid summer to maintain the weed control and keep the rich green colour until winter.

5. In autumn apply a dressing of autumn lawn feed with added moss control and apply a dressing of sulphate of iron every two months, throughout the winter and spring to keep lawn moss and weeds controlled.
